

1. Inspect and Clean Your Roof & Gutters

- LOOK FOR MISSING, CRACKED, OR CURLING SHINGLES.
- CHECK FOR SIGNS OF LEAKS IN THE ATTIC OR CEILING.
- CLEAN OUT GUTTERS AND DOWNSPOUTS TO PREVENT BLOCKAGES AND WATER DAMAGE.
- ENSURE DOWNSPOUTS DIRECT WATER AWAY FROM YOUR FOUNDATION TO AVOID FLOODING ISSUES.





2. Service Your Cooling System

Humid Northeast summers strain cooling systems, reducing efficiency if they're not maintained. A clean and tuned system lowers energy costs and helps prevent unexpected breakdowns during peak heat.

- REPLACE OR CLEAN AIR FILTERS
- CLEAR DEBRIS AROUND EXTERIOR UNITS
- SCHEDULE A PROFESSIONAL TUNE-UP
- TEST THERMOSTAT FUNCTION





3. Check for Moisture & Humidity Issues

High summer humidity can cause mold growth, wood warping, and musty odors—especially in basements common across the Northeast. Identifying moisture early helps protect your home's air quality and structural integrity.

- USE DEHUMIDIFIERS IN BASEMENTS
- INSPECT FOR DAMP SPOTS OR WATER INTRUSION
- ENSURE EXHAUST FANS WORK PROPERLY
- LOOK FOR CONDENSATION ON WINDOWS AND PIPES






4. Maintain Outdoor Spaces

After months of winter freeze and spring thaw, wooden decks, patios, and fences often need attention. Summer maintenance protects outdoor structures from sun damage and keeps them safe and enjoyable for the season.

- CLEAN AND SEAL DECKS
- POWER-WASH PATIOS AND WALKWAYS
- INSPECT FENCES FOR ROT OR LOOSE BOARDS
- REFRESH OUTDOOR FURNITURE AND CUSHIONS





6. Check Your Windows and Doors

Drafty windows and doors can let in heat and drive up your cooling costs in summer. Inspect them now for:

- CRACKED CAULKING OR WEATHER STRIPPING THAT NEEDS REPLACEMENT.
- DAMAGED SCREENS—REPAIR OR REPLACE AS NEEDED.
- CONDENSATION OR FOGGING BETWEEN DOUBLE-PANE WINDOWS (A SIGN OF SEAL FAILURE).
- FUNCTIONING LOCKS AND HANDLES FOR SECURITY.



7. Prepare Your Plumbing for Warmer Weather

Summer storms in the Northeast bring heavy rainfall that can overwhelm drainage systems.

Ensuring proper flow protects your yard, basement, and foundation from water intrusion and flooding.


- REMOVE PLANT OVERGROWTH NEAR DRAINAGE AREAS
- CLEAN OUT WINDOW WELLS
- ENSURE GRADING SLOPES AWAY FROM THE HOME
- CLEAR YARD DRAINS OF DEBRIS



6. Test and Repair Outdoor Fixtures

Outdoor lighting, decks, and fences take a beating during Metro West and Boston winters. Now's the time to check them:

- TEST ALL OUTDOOR LIGHTING AND REPLACE BULBS IF NECESSARY.
- POWER WASH YOUR DECK AND LOOK FOR LOOSE BOARDS OR NAILS.
- RESEAL OR STAIN YOUR DECK TO PROTECT IT FROM SUMMER SUN AND RAIN.
- CHECK FENCES AND GATES FOR LOOSE HINGES OR DAMAGE.





7. Pest Prevention

Warm weather attracts insects and rodents seeking food, water, and shelter—especially in older Northeast homes. Preventive steps reduce infestations and avoid costly damage from pests like carpenter ants and termites.

- SEAL EXTERIOR GAPS AND CRACKS
- REMOVE STANDING WATER AROUND THE YARD
- STORE FIREWOOD AWAY FROM THE HOUSE
- INSPECT FOR CARPENTER ANTS, TERMITES, AND WASPS










